Minutes:

School Board Members discussed the comments and questions brought before them in relation to the revisions of Policy #2262.

Mr. Terry strongly suggested looking at fee structure and rollovers, how to involve parents, and how to better define how the process works when selecting an after-school vendor.

Mrs. Curatolo shared that she was proud of the new RFQ and appreciated the pieces within the document. She is sympathetic to parent needs regarding rollover but shared her concern regarding safety. In brief review, she appreciated the Parents ROCK proposal that was submitted and would like for parents to work directly with the principal and staff at their respective schools as she is proud of the process of letting the school sites choose what is best for them. She would also like to explore the cost of summer further. Mrs. Curatolo noted on numerous occasions throughout the meeting that she is very open to communication and told the public that they could reach out to her at anytime.

Ms. Sprague commended the speakers who shared positive suggestions and would like to explore language regarding the timeline of notice for rollover. The Parents ROCK proposal will be reviewed and some of the items would be included into the revised policy.

Mrs. Berry noted that there were a lot of good suggestions shared and plans to look at fee structure. She reiterated that the Parents ROCK proposal will be reviewed and the ideas may be incorporated into the revised policy.

## Superintendent's Recommendations

Minutes:

Dr. Kamela Patton thanked everyone for their time and appreciated those that went online before the meeting to give direct feedback to the documents which were posted. Based on the comments from the June School Board Meeting, fee structure was a top priority when making the initial revisions. Key items taken away from the Workshop include the following:

- A process for fee rollover should be researched and feedback should be collected from those that have done it successfully.
- The Parent Solution offered by Parents ROCK will be reviewed to see what can be incorporated into Policy #2262.
- The District will look at incorporating more sports into its after-school programs.

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Based on the extensive amount of changes to the revisions, this item may be a First Reading at the November School Board Meeting. A final assessment will be done based on the amount of changes.
